As a result, some may have reduced hours or appointment-only immunization clinics. Please check with your county health department before making any referrals.



REMINDER: If your VFC clinic is modifying operations, you must:

- email [arizonavfc@azdhs.gov](mailto:arizonavfc@azdhs.gov) with the hours your site can accept vaccine deliveries
- continue to store and monitor vaccines according to Arizona VFC requirements
- report all temperature excursions via the electronic Incident Report on the ASIIS log-in page or PDF Incident Report
- contact your Immunization Program Specialist (IPS) for any questions
