



AHCCCS Update: Minimum Subcontract Provisions

September 1, 2020

AHCCCS made a number of updates to the Minimum Subcontract Provisions effective October 1, 2020. The following highlights the major updates. We encourage you to review the entire document, which can be found on the AHCCCS website <http://www.azahcccs.gov/>:

Choose “Plans/Providers” > “Health Plans > “Minimum Subcontract Provisions”

1. Clarified the definition of Subcontract. “*Subcontract*” means any Contract between the AHCCCS contracted Managed Care Organization and a third party for the performance of any or all services or requirements specified under the MCO’s Contract with AHCCCS, and includes any Provider Participation Agreement or Group Biller Agreement with AHCCCS.
2. Revised Federal Immigration and Nationality Act, Prior Authorization and Utilization Management and Record Retention.
3. Added a provision regarding DUGless Data Reporting
4. Added provisions as a result of the Report of the Abuse & Neglect Prevention Task Force to Governor Douglas A. Ducey (November 1, 2019) developed in response to Executive Order 2019-03, and
 - Adult Protective Services Registry Check
 - Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation Prevention
 - Corporate Governance for Providers
5. Removed Certification of Truthfulness of Representation, Limitations on Billing and Collection Practices, and Termination of Subcontract.
